

FGV Contributes RM300,000 to 300 Flood Victims in Yan, Kedah

KUALA LUMPUR, 13 September 2021 - FGV Holdings Berhad (FGV) recently contributed RM300,000 in cash and FGV products to 300 residents affected by last month's floods in Yan, Kedah.
