

FGV Distributes 13,000 Bags of Subsidiaries Food Products

Kuala Lumpur, 26 March 2020: FGV Holdings Berhad (FGV) has taken proactive steps, as a responsible corporate citizen, to assist Malaysians in need as the country undergoes the Movement Control Order.

A total of 13,000 bags will be distributed under the FGV Food Relief Bag (FGV FreB) / [F.G.V. Free.bee] programme, containing basic foods such as rice, SAJI cooking oil, PRAI sugar, SAJI mountain salt, SAJI instant noodles, SAJI sweetened creamer, SAJI evaporated creamer and SAJI chili sauce, products of the FGV Group.

FGV Group Chief Executive Officer, Dato' Haris Fadzilah Hassan said the contributions are meant for the B40 group, especially those affected by pay cuts and those dependent on daily wages.

"We understand the needs of the community especially for families in this trying times to ensure that food is always available. Being involved directly in the food supply chain industry, this contribution is very close to the heart and part of the FGV Group's continuous effort to support the Shared Prosperity Vision 2030," said Haris Fadzilah.

The first 3,000 of FGV FReB were dispatched on Wednesday, 25 March to selected NGOs namely Pertubuhan Amal Ibnu Sina Malaysia (PAPISMA) Selangor Division, Pertubuhan Kebajikan Islam (PERKIM) Kapar Division, Selangor and Teraju Ekonomi Asnaf (TERAS).

The balance of the contribution will be distributed to several other locations under the coordination of the Ministry of Plantation and Industries Commodity.
